About CZ.NIC

- Special interest association of legal entities
- Founded in 1998 by group of 16 ISPs
- Open membership
- 53 members - growing
- Registry-Registrar model (17 registrars)
- Liberal registration model – no restrictions
- 320.000 registered domains
- Member of EURid (.EU)

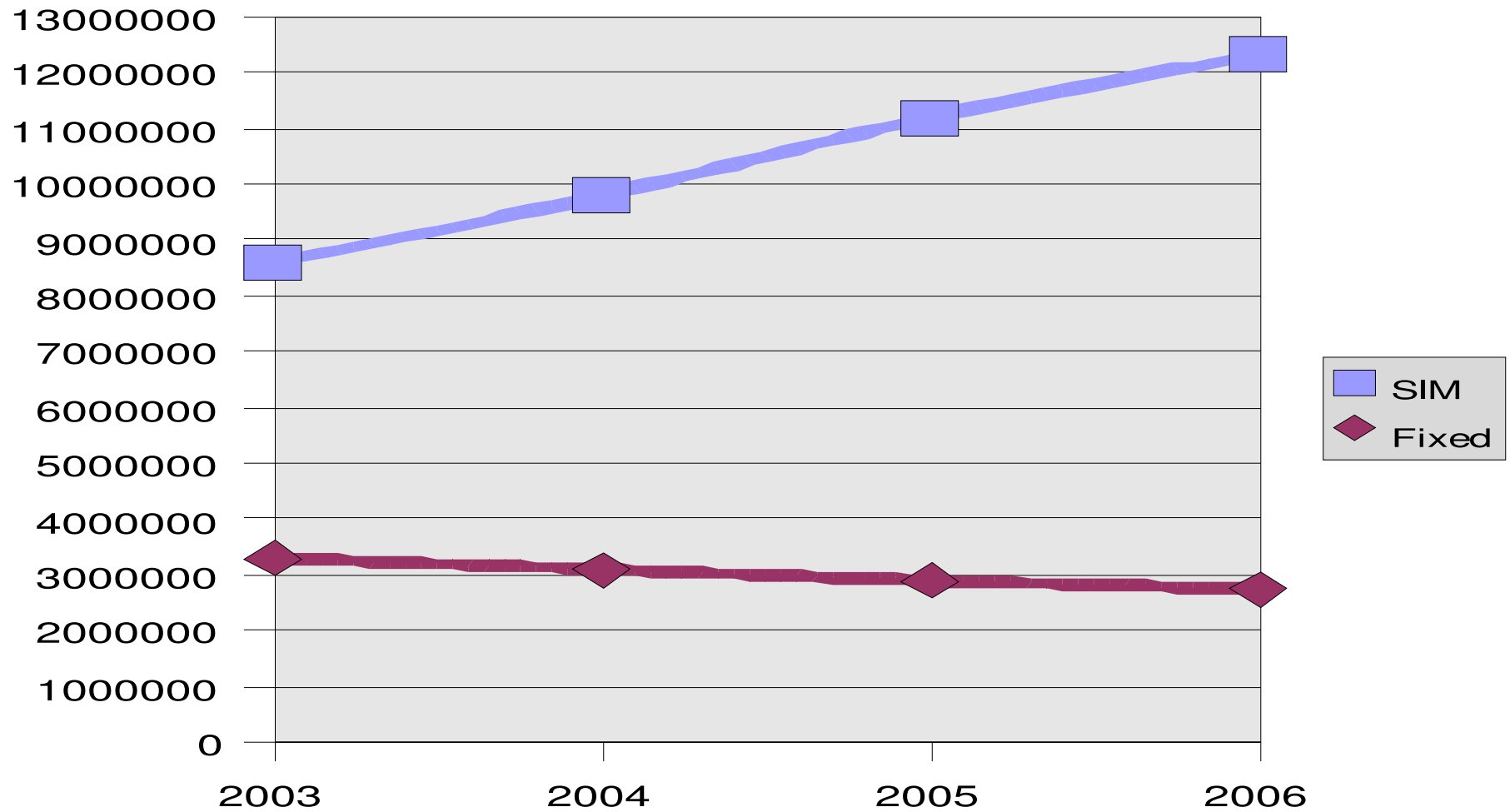
Situation in Czech Republic

- Prefix +420
- Closed numbering plan – 3+9 digits
- <http://www.ctu.cz/main.php?pageid=212>
- Strong incumbent operator – Telefonica O2 CR
- High mobile phone penetration (over 120%)
- Interconnection costs
- Slow unbundling
- Number portability - fixed, mobile

Situation in Czech Republic

- VoIP operators – small but many
- Using VoIP own infrastructure – stronger – UPC
- Using common Internet – many (Asterisk)
- Open SIP URLs – ENUM numbers registration
- Geographical and non-geographical numbers
- Usually free intra-provider calls
- About 70.000 users

Fixed vs Mobile



0.2.4.e164.arpa history

- 2003 0.2.4.e164.arpa delegated to CZ.NIC
- 2003-2006 pre-trial (manually, >100 EUR fee)
 - 75 domains – academic
- 4/2006 Agreement with Ministry of Informatics
- 4/2006 new registry software development started
- 20.9.2006 trial launched
 - 2000 domains
- 22.1.2007 full commercial operation launched

Vision

- Help ENUM/VoIP grow
 - Cheap
 - Simple
- Fast to commercial phase

Reasons for trial

- No technical testing – ENUM just works
- Validation method tuning – different in each country
- Processes tuning
- Many thanks to AT and DE

- Keep it short
- Don't delete database

0.2.4.e164.arpa conditions

- Allowed numbers:
 - Geographical numbers
 - Non-geographical numbers (VoIP range)
 - Cellular numbers
 - Toll-free / split costs lines numbers
 - Premium services numbers
- × 1 to 10 years registration
 - Validation once per 6 months :(- SMS, call, invoice

0.2.4.e164.arpa conditions

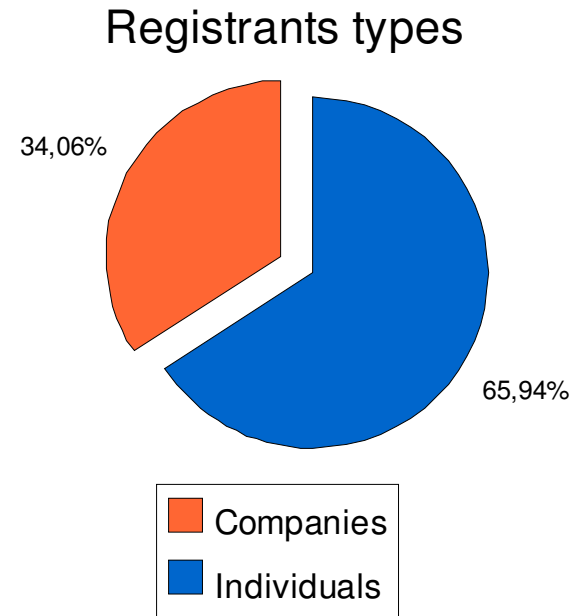
- Single numbers or blocks
 - End user only!
 - Semi automatic process of block break-ups
- Promo price 1 CZK (0,04 EUR)
 - 2007 and 2008
 - later expected at about 150 CZK (5 EUR) - BUT

Current situation

- 11 registrars
- 4 telco operators supporting ENUM
 - VoIP operators – no big player yet
 - ENUM lookup on outgoing calls (covering about 23 500 users)
 - One operator doing registration for the customers (more on the way)
 - Others support unofficially

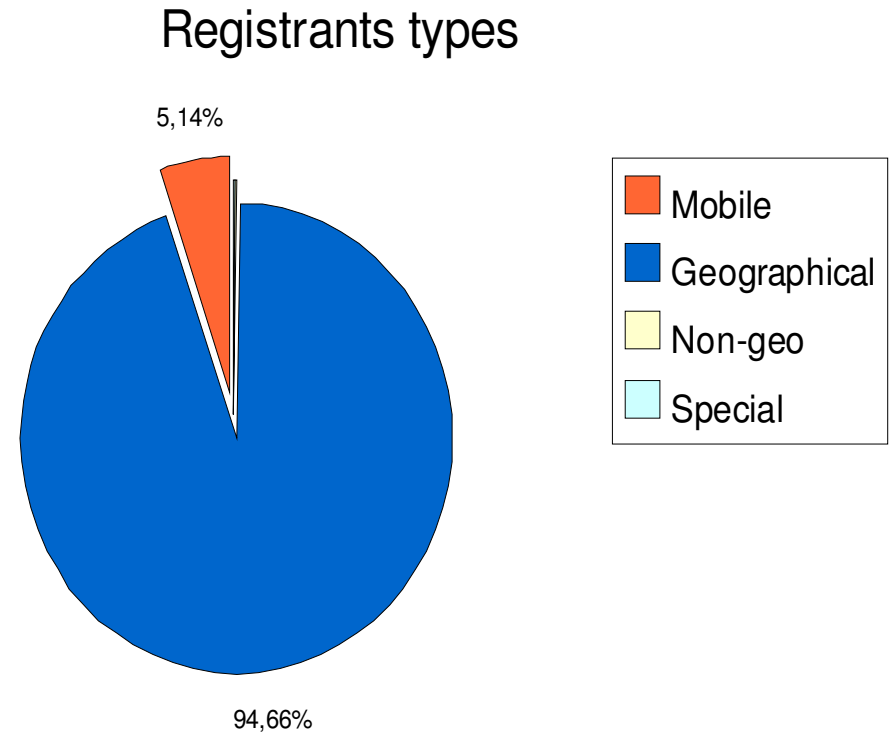
Current situation

- 2510 domains registered
- 554 768 numbers
- Mainly individuals
- Most registrations from telco
 - 2196 domains
- Active / passive registrars



Current situation

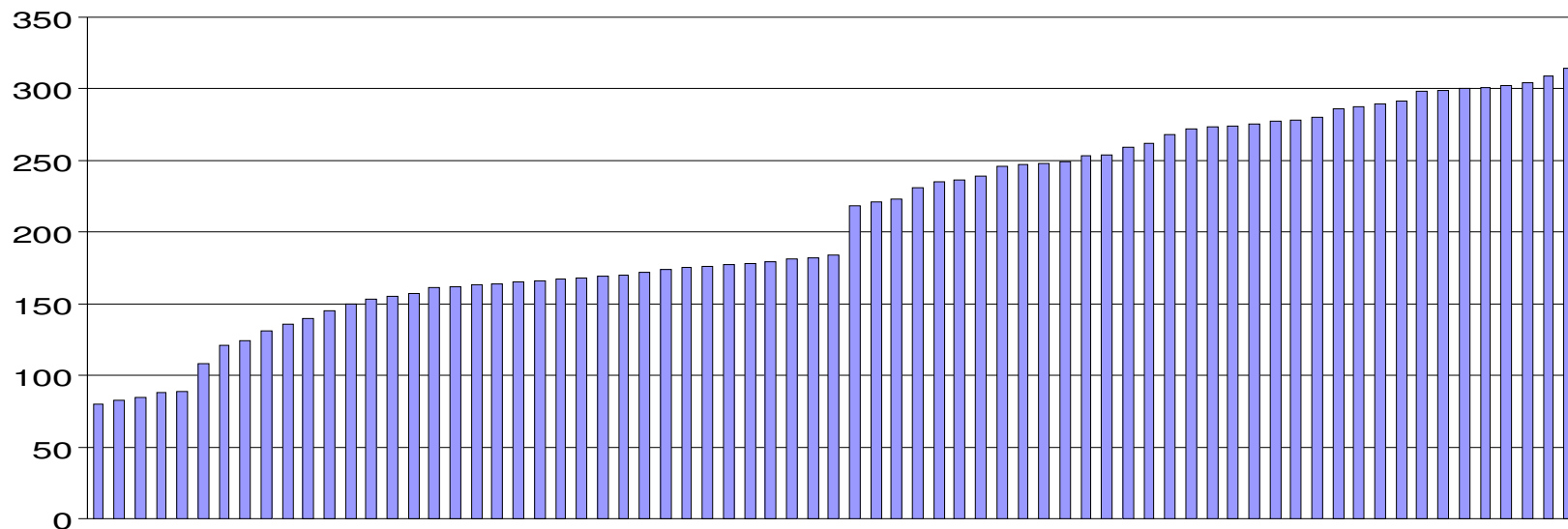
- Majority – geographical
- 2 free number (800)
- 3 non-geographical
- 129 mobiles



Current situation

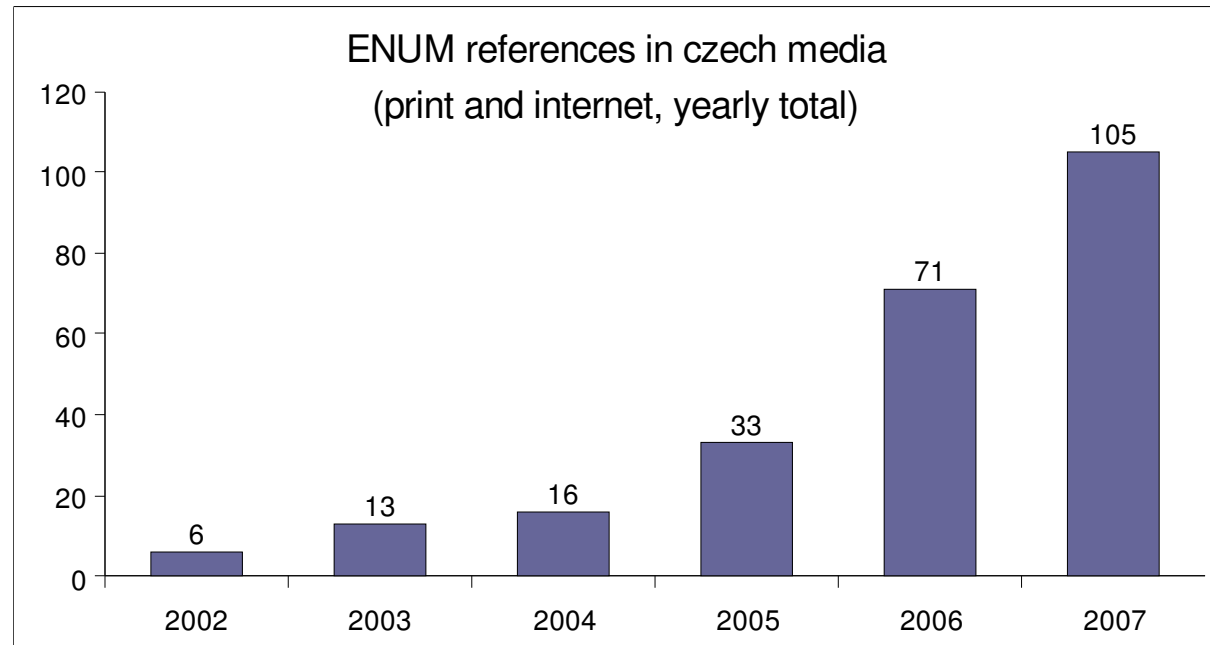
- Growth since trial (w/o telco registrations)
- 33 domains per month average
- Depends on communication
- Faster after commercial launch

0.2.4.e164.arpa registered subdomains (w/o telco)



Current situation

- High media coverage



- Internet and print regularly, 65:35 % ratio
- Radio and TV !

Registry software

- Free software for registration - FRED

FREE REGISTRY FOR ENUM AND DOMAINS

- Opensource – GPL



- EPP/SSL based

- Usable for regular domain and ENUM

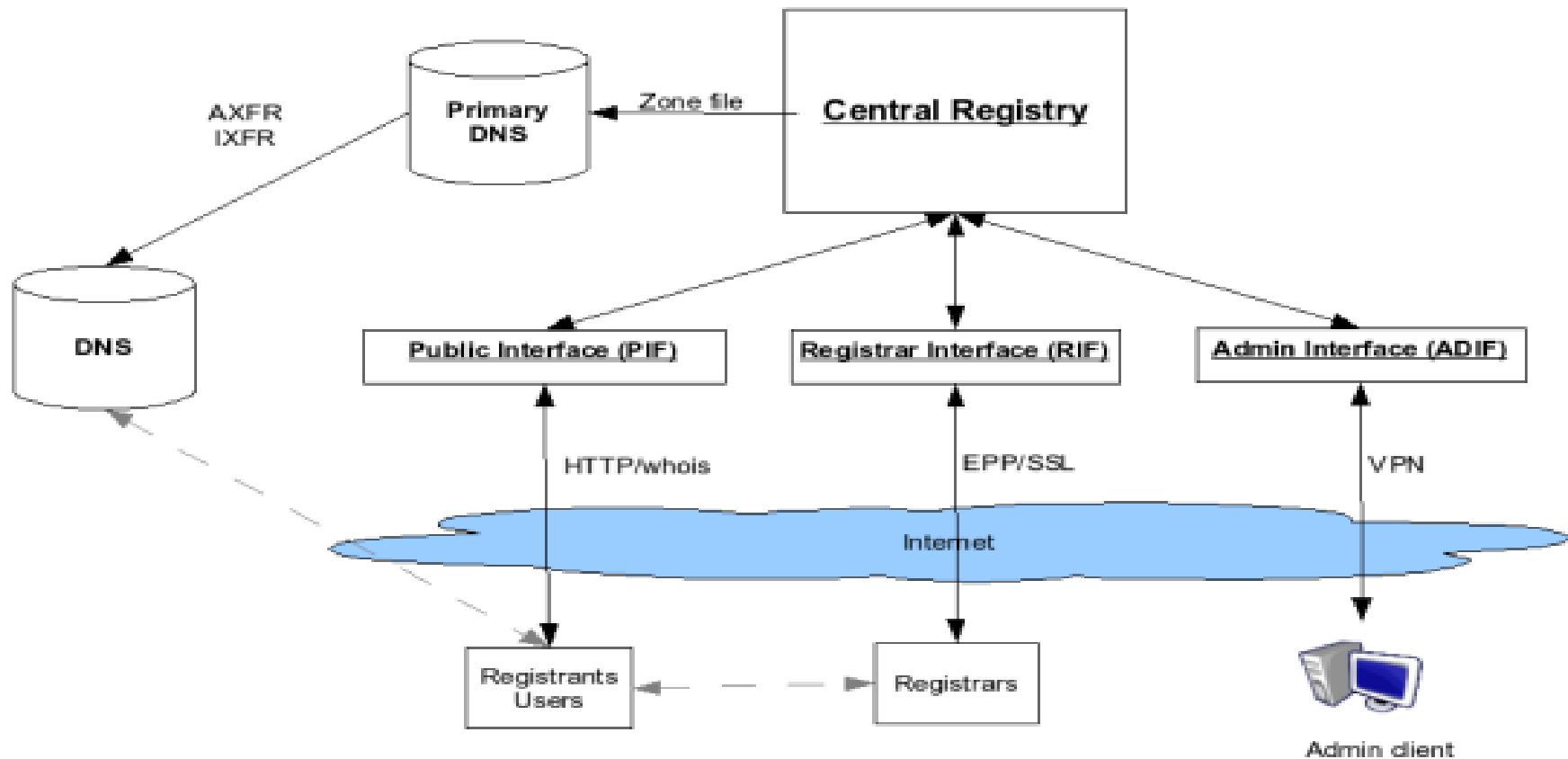
- Able to manage more domains/zones

- Will be used for .cz as well (contact sharing) - 10/07

Registry software



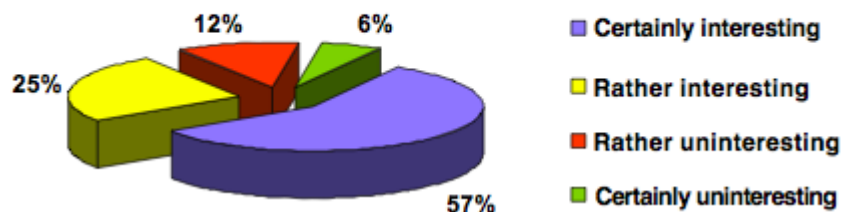
Current issues

- ENUM too complicated for End Users
- Validation – not for telco BUT
- Snowball
- Mobile phone operators
- VoIP operators
- Enterprises

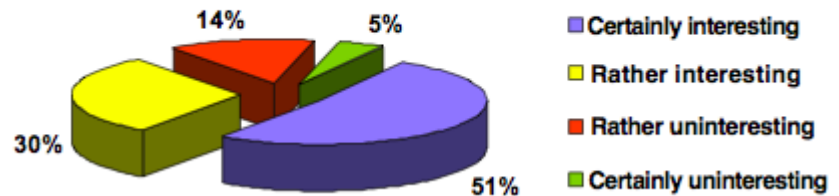
Future plans

 - HOWTOs
- Target end users (both companies and individuals)
 - Market research January 2007
