ESIF financing Broadband 2007-2013

- € 2.3 bn of ERDF for broadband infrastructure
 - but some Member States re-programmed fund to other domains (e.g. SK, EL, PL)
- € 1 Bn of EAFRD for Broadband *available* under the European Economic Recovery Package (2009)
 - but only 369M actually programmed;
 - > a missed opportunity
- Lessons from 2007-2013 period:
 - Delayed absorption, re-programming
 - Due to lack of administrative capacity to plan ; in some cases, poor coordination between relevant entities

EU financing Broadband 2014-2020

- *Many different EU funding instruments...*
- *1. ERDF - BB Funding:..... € 5 bn*
- *2. EAFRD - BB Funding:..... € 0.8 bn*
- *3. Connecting Europe Facility (CEF):..... € 0.15 bn*
- *4. EIB / EIF (2014): € 2.4 bn*
- *5. European Fund for Strategic Investment (EFSI)*

... and National & Regional funding .

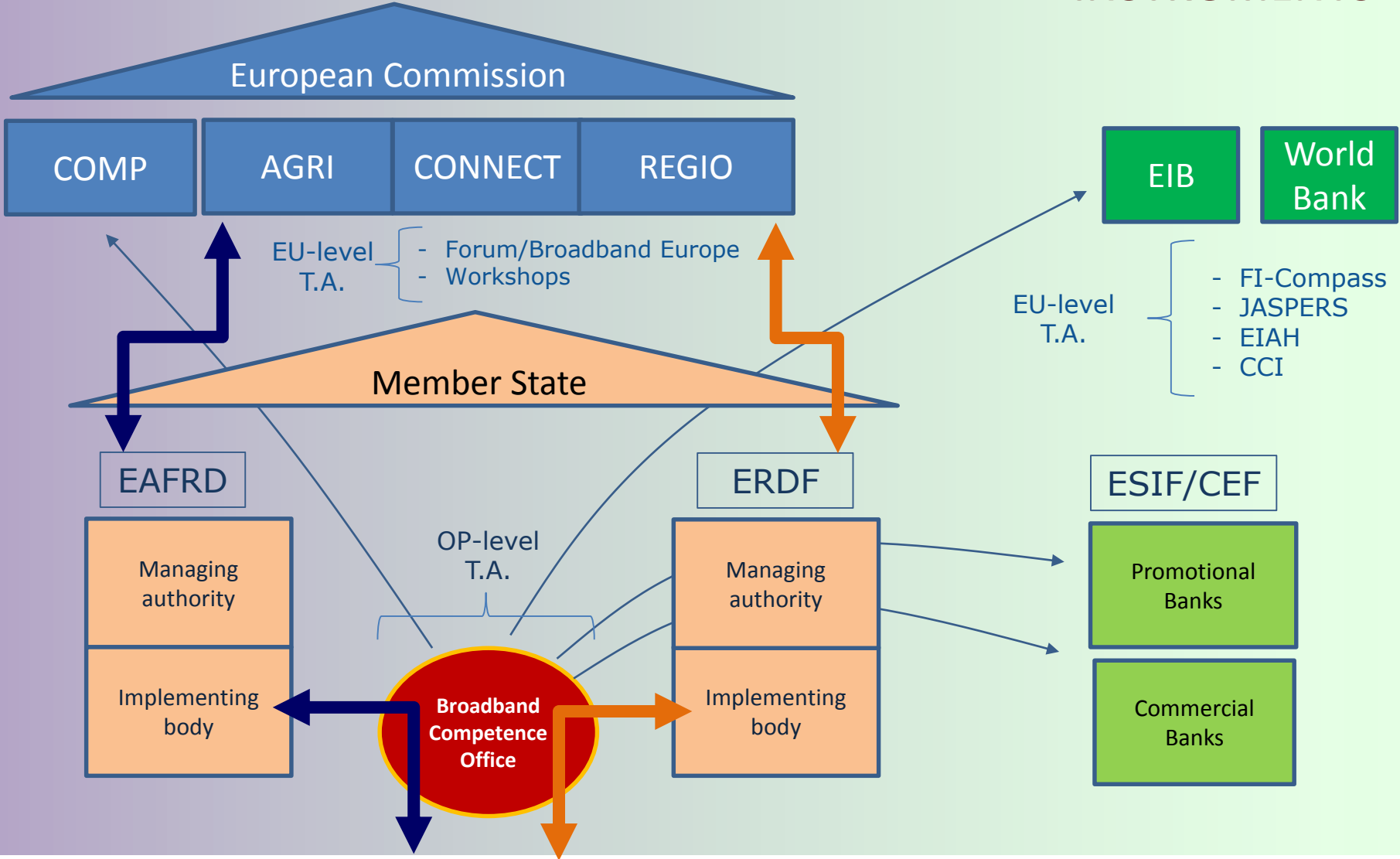
- ***Voluntary initiative*** : some 77 Regions and 22 Member States concerned - though the initiative is open to all.
- **30 November: Member State (MS) to designate "Contact Person(s)"** to discuss preparatory steps and report progress;
- **April 2016: MS to designate BCO members (at national and/or regional level).**
- **Financial support from ESIF technical assistance budget or within OPs/RDPs**

BCO: Main Aims

- Provide advice and assistance to stakeholders (citizens, businesses, etc.) about EU funding opportunities;
- Enhance efficiency and effectiveness of ERDF/EAFRD broadband investments (planning, implementation, monitoring);
- Coordination between OP and RDP and with other relevant entities (e.g. Ministry, National Regulatory Authorities, Mapping entities, etc.);
- Promote the use of financial instruments where necessary.

Setting up of BCOs a few hints

- BCOs are not meant to be *additional* administrative structures, but rather to *reinforce existing* ones : expected to be set up within each Implementing Body responsible for the delivery of ESIF measures on broadband
- Forms and functions of BCOs may vary depending on the institutional set-up of the Member State or Region: they may operate at different levels of government, etc.
- Should the setting up of a BCO require additional resources, the OP/RDP's technical assistance allocation may be used for that purpose.
- BCO contact persons will be regularly called to workshops (on average 1 meeting every 6 months) to exchange with other members of the network.

Tasks for the experts

[only for those countries concerned]

- **Promote the concept of BCOs** and report perception from relevant stakeholders;
- **Identify gaps and obstacles** preventing a smooth implementation of broadband measures by OPs/RDPs;
- **Verify information/data available** at European level (Broadband Europe country fiches, ICT monitoring data, etc.) against ground field data.
